


The Venue

The conference centre is in the heart of the SilverStar village. It provides an ideal set-up with the flexibility to handle upwards of 100 delegates. Catering is provided by the dedicated team at the Vance Creek Resort and the 1609 Restaurant.

SilverStar is one of the world's best, yet undiscovered, mountain resorts. Some of the adjectives applicable to SilverStar are picturesque, diverse, intimate, challenging, friendly, convenient. Indicative program

APE dates are designed to fit comfortably within Southern Hemisphere school holidays but outside of Northern Hemisphere vacation periods. This means that the resort is virtually **queue free** during the conference.

Most of the official conference program is compressed into the **4pm to 7pm** period. In addition to the formal presentations there are two social functions; an icebreaker on the Monday evening and the conference dinner on Thursday.



Catering is sufficient to cover the whole family at social functions. We'll contact you for numbers and dietary requirements as the conference date approaches. We can cater for most requirements - gluten free, vegetarian etc.

Each year we select a theme to inspire the program. The theme for 2019 is "Bonds". We encourage as many delegates as possible to think about presenting. We endeavour to incorporate all presentations into the program. By having more presenters it means that we have shorter presentations and more diverse subjects.



Logistics

The first step in securing your attendance at APE is to organise travel and accommodation. There are many options for doing this ranging from doing it all yourself or working with one of a number of professional companies. Bookings are now open for season 2019.

Popular itineraries for Australians are direct flights from Sydney, Melbourne or Brisbane to Vancouver and then connecting to Kelowna. From Kelowna it is just over an hour by shuttle



to your accommodation in SilverStar. People are also taking advantage of a number of direct flights from US ports (LA and SF) to Kelowna.

Registration

You can register for APE on line - the earlier the better. The registration process takes you to a payment option via Pay-Pal where you can use a PayPal account or credit card.

Registration Fees start at \$1320 but can be as little as \$880 as per the table below.

Registration represents outstanding value for this level of conference with attendant social functions. This is particularly the case given that APE is not supported by corporate sponsorship. Funding the conference purely from registration fees has been a factor in



keeping the conference free of commercial influence and distractions and ensuring that delegates are free to present and ask questions in an un-compromising way.
